

Rules and Regulations

The following is prohibited while on the Marina property and waterway:

1. Entering any storage building or maintenance shop (Boatel, Service or Rigging Departments)
2. Consuming alcoholic beverages on Marina property or at Marina docks.
3. Swimming, fishing, crabbing, diving, or the use of minnow traps from our docks or your boat
4. Cleaning fish in unauthorized areas. Dumping or throwing fish refuse in any body of water
This area is under 24 hr. video surveillance
5. Unleashed animals
6. Parking of cars, trucks, or trailers in unauthorized or incorrect (blocking lanes) manner.
All vehicles blocking lanes or fire lanes will be towed at the owner's expense
7. Smoking at fuel docks, launching areas, work racks, or in any posted "no smoking" areas
8. Discard trash in provided receptacles only. Fish refuse only in receptacles on the fish dock and specified for fish refuse - not in dumpsters please!!!!
9. Using abusive language or behavior to Marina employees, guests or other Boatel customers.
10. Draining oil or any petroleum products
You will be charged for any cleaning costs, and your contract will be terminated immediately
11. Damaging Marina property
12. Lynnhaven River Watershed is an EPA no discharge zone. City Code 6-127 defines the law.
Boat overboard discharge capability must be rendered inoperable
13. Draining bilges into basin or on facility - You will be charged for any cleaning costs
14. Running an engine in gear while secured to dock or slips
15. Unsafe, unlawful or disorderly conduct. Violation of city, state or federal laws.
16. Filling fuel tanks to 100% to hauling (**no more than 90%**). Fueling from portable container.
17. Performing any work or estimates on a boat owner's boat done by anyone other than the owner of that boat. **All outside contractors must be pre-authorized, scheduled and supervised by the Service Department**
18. Performing any prohibited work at waterfront or on wash racks - **i.e. drive removal, engine removal, bottom painting, power washing, changing oil, major mechanical work, etc.**
Your contract will be terminated immediately
19. Plug removal of boat in boatel. Plugs must be in boat at all times. Boats in the service lot will have plug removed for safety
20. Open fires or overnight parking in any parking lot. Inform the Launch Office if you need to leave a vehicle overnight, a designated parking area will be assigned
21. Walking into or across the gravel area. Please walk around
22. Boats will not be launched to the water if a balance is owed to any department
Service balances are due at the time of completion
23. Drinking alcohol on marina property. This includes if your boat is in the water tied to a dock
24. If a pet is found off leash and/or if the leash is not being held on to by a responsible party while on marina property. This includes if your boat is in the water tied to a dock.
